How to get Registered

1. Buy a minimum matching pair of pants and jersey from the **2010 FLY Racing Line** . 2010 FLY Racing Line consists of : **Evolution Gear, Kinetic Gear, Free Ride Gear, and F-16 Gear in either Adult or Youth sizes.**
Must provide original purchased receipt.
2. Must fill out the **Contingency Registration Form** below, along with your **original receipt** to FLY Racing/Idaho State MX Series Contingency Program, attention Chris Valle at 601 E. Gowen Rd., Boise, ID 83716. Registration Forms must be filled out completely and legible. Be sure to indicate **which class you are participating in.** Incomplete or unreadable Registration Forms will be returned and not processed. Upon receiving a returned Registration Form it is up to the rider to fill out a new form and resend it in.
3. Riders that are competing in multiple classes must notate on Registration Form.
4. **ONLY** after completed Registration Forms are received will a participant be eligible for the contingency program, **NOT** from the day dated on the Contingency Registration Form.

What you get

1. The FLY Racing/**Series Name** Contingency Program will pay points to registered riders finishing **1st thru 10th** place for each event in all classes in the 2010 series. Points schedule is as follows:

1st Place = 25 Points	6th Place = 10 Points
2nd Place = 22 Points	7th Place = 7 Points
3rd Place = 20 Points	8th Place = 4 Points
4th Place = 18 Points	9th Place = 3 Points
5th Place = 16 Points	10th Place = 1 Points

Points earned will be tallied at the end of the series and converted to "Race Bucks" at the rate of \$1 (retail) per point. In order for points to be awarded, there must be a minimum of five (5) riders in each class per race.

2. All riders must meet series attendance requirements to be eligible for points. Riders on free product support contracts or discounted sponsorship will not be eligible unless they follow all the guidelines for a non-sponsored rider.
3. Contingency certificates, "Race Bucks", will be mailed to riders and must be redeemed in person to any Western Power Sports Dealer and are **ONLY valid towards WPS/FLY product purchases.** Payout is subject to promoter limitations or restrictions.

- Rider Registration.** In order to register for the Contingency Program racers need to fill out and return the Registration Form and must purchase one pant and one jersey from a single dealer. Apparel must be from the **2010 FLY Racing Line** which consists of : Evolution Gear, Kinetic Gear, Free Ride Gear, and F-16 Gear in either Adult or Youth sizes.
- Contingency Payout.** The Contingency Program will pay points to registered riders finishing **1st thru 10th** place for each event in all classes in the 2010 series. In order for points to be awarded, there must be a minimum of five (5) riders in each class per race.. Rider must meet series attendance requirements to be eligible for points. Points schedule is as follows:

1st Place = 25 Points	6th Place = 10 Points
2nd Place = 22 Points	7th Place = 7 Points
